Dear Residents, Families and Friends

Although there have been some changes to the Covid 19 mandates within the community we would like to advise everyone that all precautions remain the same here at Palisade Gardens and James Club. Mask must continue to be worn, and testing is still required upon entry to the facility for staff and visitors.

Today, there are still approximately 30 retirement homes in an active outbreak of covid 19. Due to the fragility of our population, it is imperative that we “stay on course” for the time being. Although masking is no longer required in the public, Covid is still present. Removing a layer of protection does add greater risk of spread.
